


CHAZON TEKNA Methodology

Christian Philosophy

Our school uses the American Schooling system: Accelerated Christian Education or ACE. All our work is Bible based. Students are taught to memorize scripture and learn Gospel songs.

Every book that they work in has a scripture that they need to memorize and the 60 Christian Character Traits like honesty, kindness and respect are integrated throughout our curriculum.

Quality Status and Staff

Step x Step

This class is for 3-4 year Old's.

Students start to learn the English language in this class.

Students learn through play. They start to learn about shapes and numbers. This is done by tracing examples, coloring pictures and forming the numbers in the air.

They learn to listen to stories and then color pictures about it.

They develop motor and fundamental skills by doing physical activities e.g. threading, cutting, playing on the jungle gym etc.) Everything in this class is learnt through playing.



Preschool

This class is for 5-6 year Old's. We continue to develop motor skills through play. Students start



to learn the Phonetic Alphabet. This alphabet is different from the regular ABC's because there are symbols on the letters which show you how to pronounce the sound.

They start to work in booklets called PACEs.

Students learn to listen to, and follow instructions. They do a lot of group work and no child is left behind.





ABC

This is our Gr. 1 class. Students start the year with the ABC Learning To Read program. The first 6 months of the year prepares them to start reading. They use the phonetic alphabet to read.

While most of the work is still group work, the students start to do some things individually. They each have their own "office" to work in. Every PACE starts with a scripture that the students need to memorize. The pages in the PACEs have instructions that the children must read before completing the work that follows.



Once a section of work is completed, there is a score strip where students must go to score their own work. The teacher will then double check that scoring has been done correctly. Students are taught responsibility by scoring their own work.

Learning Centre

This is our Gr. 2-12 class. Here students start to learn Afrikaans as their second language. We do not write exams. Work is divided into 72 PACEs or booklets. Each PACE has Checkups (mini tests) and Self-Tests throughout to test if the students has mastered the work. A bigger test is written when the PACE is completed.

Students learn to plan & take responsibility for their own work by setting their own goals to complete each day. Students work at their own tempo and students who excel can even complete more than one grade in a year.

Computer Education

We have a dedicated computer center and students already start using computers at

Preschool Level. From Preschool to Gr 1 they mainly learn through playing. From Gr 2-6 they start using the Futurekids Curriculum. They learn the basics like Excel, Word, Powerpoint

and Publisher.

From Gr 7 they do Skillspro. Skillspro gives them a NQF Level 3, SAQA certificate in Matric, which is recognized all over the world. They will be able to do any office work like budgets, presentations, CV's and they can also use the internet and E-mail.

We do sport on Tuesdays and Thursday afternoons. We offer a variety of items like Athletics, Soccer, Netball, Softball and

Volleyball. Many of our students have qualified to compete on National Level in Athletics.
